She has two children, Jesus (15) and Brenda (12), a nephew Rudy (22), and her mother (72) living under the same roof...a rented house made of adobe and sheet metal. The cost to join the team is \$250 which goes towards the materials

and local labor required to build the house. Team members receive daily updates the week of the build, exclusive access to photos and videos, and your name on the trip webpage if you would like. In addition, you will receive status updates prior, during, and after build week until the home is completed and dedicated. We are looking for 32 team members to fully fund the build, but any donation is very much appreciated.
